1. Introduction

2.1 Personal Information:

- Nostr npub
- Name
- Email address
- Payment information
- Location

2.2 Non-Personal Information:

We may collect non-personal information, such as:

- Browser type
- Device information
- IP address
- Usage data
- Cookies and tracking technologies

3. How We Use Your Information

We may use the information we collect for various purposes, including:

- To provide and maintain our services

- To communicate with you, including sending confirmations, updates, and customer support
- To personalize your experience on our platform

While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your data, no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

- **Right to Object:** You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information under certain circumstances.
